

I INTERNATIONAL OPEN" PALACIO DE PIONEROS"

SCHEDULE: Saturday, 23rd to Friday, 29th July 2016

VENUE: Stadium Venecia, Calle de Fray Julián Garcés, 100 (Zaragoza).

SYSTEM OF PLAY: Swiss System, 9 rounds

RHYTHM: 90 minutes with 30 second increment from move 1

ENROLMENT: Entry fees for the Open Tournament must be paid no later than Wednesday, 20 July 2016

COMPETITION GROUPS: The groups of play will be established according to the following criteria:

- FIDE rating
- Spanish Rating, FEDA
- Title
- Aragonés rating, FADA
- Alphabetical Order

<u>DEFAULT TIME:</u> Players arriving 30 minutes or more after the start of a session shall lose, unless the arbiter decides otherwise.



APPEALS COMMITTEE: The Organization will choose the Committee during the first Round of the Open. It shall be composed of:

- Two holder players and two alternate ones. All of them must be at least 16 years.
- The Tournament Director and an oficial representative of the Open.
- The Tournament Director shall be the chairman of the Competition Committee.

BYES: A player may request a maximum of 2 byes.

- The bye for a particular game may be notified in writing to the chief arbiter before the end of the previous Round.
- The byes may be only requested for the first 5 Rounds of the tournament.
- For each requested bye, ½ point will be assigned.
- The player may also request not to be paired in any Round.

SPECIFIC RULES OF PARTICIPATION: Any player who fails to attend two consecutive or alternate Rounds, will be automatically eliminated from the tournament.

■ The Organization shall eliminate any player who does not attend the first Round.

<u>UNSPORTING BEHAVIOUR</u>: Any unsporting behaviour may be penalised with the player elimination from the Tournament.

■ The Organization reserves the right to refuse admission.

MOBILE PHONES, SMOKING RULES AND FOOD:

- In line with new FIDE guidelines, all mobile phones, tablets, and similar mobile devices are banned from the playing areas. The Organization may keep the players mobile phones, in case of emergency.
- Smoking is forbidden in the playing areas, except for their outdoor terraces.
- Bringing food or beverages is forbidden.



PLAYING AREAS: Players may not leave the game halls without justification or permission of a arbiter while in their games. If they are needed to leave, they must notify to the arbiters.

CLAIMS: Any claim with of an arbiter decision will have to be filed (black and white) to the Competition Committee. It should be done a maximum of one hour after the end of the game in dispute. A deposit of 30€ must be lodged. If the dispute is successful, then the deposite will be returned to the player.

PAIRINGS: At the end of each round, and once validated by the arbiters, partial results and rankings will be published both at the playing areas, and at the official Festival website: www.palaciodepioneros.es

- The first round pairings will be communicated during the Opening Ceremony

TIE-BREAKS: The tie-breaks for the final classifications will be as follows:

Direct Encounter.

After finishing the last round, a drawing will be held among the following tie breaks:

- Medium Bucholz 1
- Bucholz cut 1
- Sum of Bucholz
- Sum of Progressive Scores

For the purposes of calculating the Buchholz systems, the FIDE "virtual opponent" method will apply for unplayed games.

 - ✓ GENERAL ADULT FEE: EUR 35, if registered before 1st July 2016. If the registration is confirmed after that date, then the registration fee will be EUR 40.
 - ✓ <u>JUNIOR FEE</u>: Any player who has born during 2001 and beyond is considered a junior player. These junior players will pay **EUR 30**.

- The registration fee must be paid to the Organization during the first Round or before starting.
- The Organization of the Internantional Open may reject any player who fail to comply with this requirement.

- ✓ Unregistered players, when the first Round is about to start, may not play that Round. If admitted, the player must contact the Organization of the Open before the end of the first Round, so that he can be paired in the next Round.
- ✓ The Organisers reserve the right to make some small specific modification in tournaments' schedules, in order to improve their development.
- ✓ Although expected to be an improbable circumstance, if any changes occur, players will be notified well in advance.
